



Leaf guard Method 2

Part: FGRDGG



To fasten leaf guard to fascia not gutter

Determine gutter placement on fascia. Does the drip edge get in your way of application?
Is there enough of fascia exposed above the gutter?

To apply leaf guard to G-60 (4x5) or G75 if there is enough fascia above the gutter exposed you can angle the leaf guard and screw through the leaf guard flange into the fascia board. If you do not have the fascia height or the drip edge is in your way you can rip the leaf guard using a saw.



To apply leaf guard to G-90 (4x6) if there is enough fascia above the gutter exposed you can apply the leaf guard and screw through the leaf guard flange into the fascia board. If you do not have the fascia height or the drip edge is in your way you can rip the leaf guard using a saw. And angle screws at back of gutter into fascia
